Sealmatic constantly adheres to the regulation proposed for GMP, by ensuring and managing the risks to the unsafe substances.

The reports provided by us in the audit process (report no. Q11041/2021) conducted as per TÜV India procedures, has been effectively confirmed for GMP certification, affirming that the mechanical seals manufactured at Sealmatic does not contain any unsafe or hazardous substances, and is complaint to the norms and standards proposed by Food Hygiene CAC/RCP 1-1969, rev. 4, (2003). In addition, the materials investigated for GMP, are been thoroughly inspected and confirmed that we meet all the necessities as characterized as per CAC.
